sometimes available tools are an awkward fit





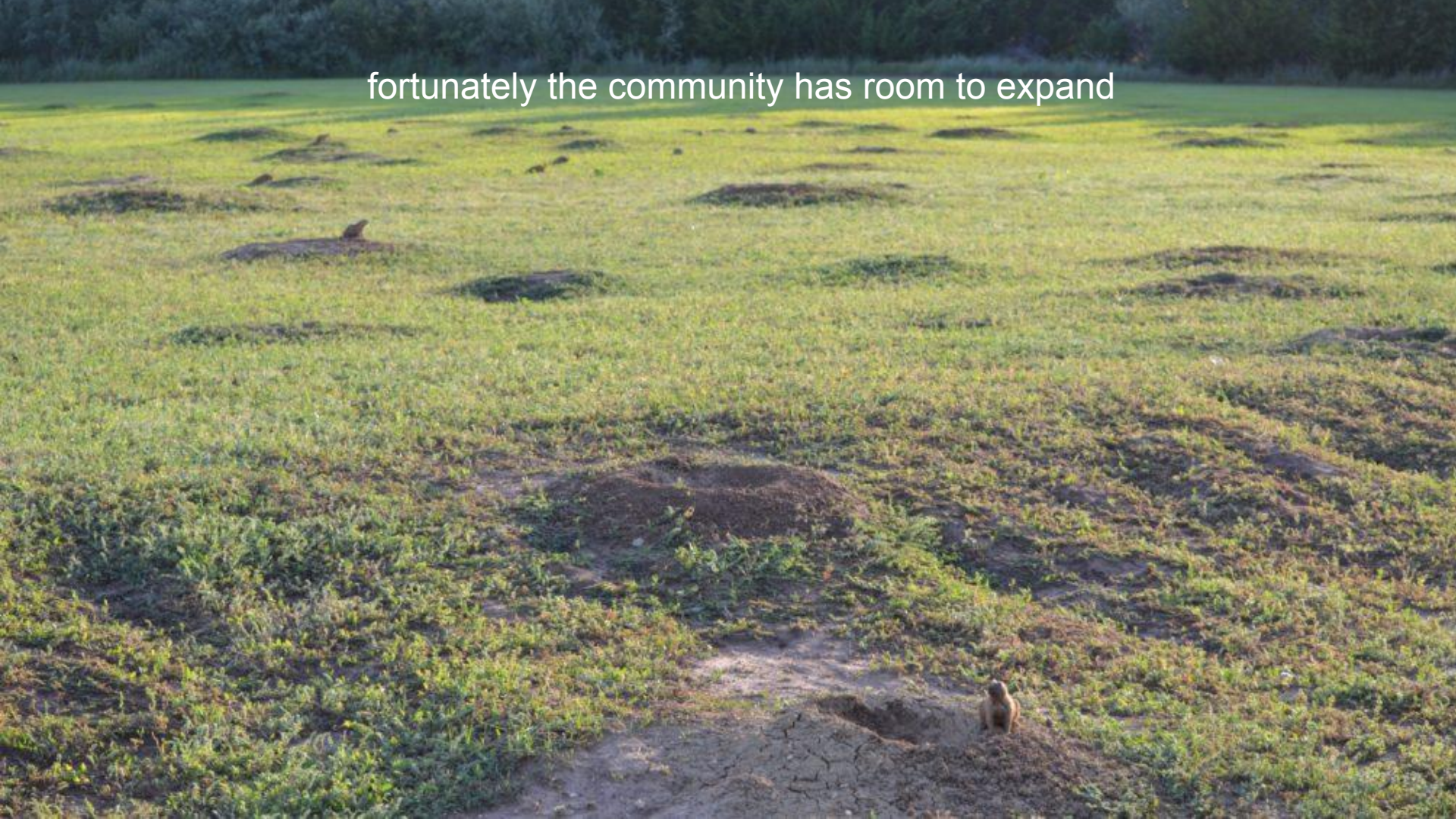
it can be easy to grow too quickly
