

# Why OER?



Reduce overall cost of course materials



Integrate multiple sources and resource types



Ability to customize, adapt, and update

### Goals



NOT replicate a traditional textbook



Streamlined



Interactive

## Project Process

#### **Summer 2023**

Complete first several chapters and at least begin some others

Learn Pressbooks and H5P

#### Fall 2023

Pilot period

Roll out chapters as they were "completed," making other edits/tweaks along the way

#### **Spring 2024**

Finalize chapters

Continue making small edits/tweaks along the way

Review and publish

### Summer 2024 (and beyond)

Maintain/update resource, as needed

Develop/make available ancillary material

Begin new OER project(s), including co-creation
